

## **NOTICE OF PRIMARY**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN**, that on Tuesday, the 4th day of August, 2020, a Primary will be conducted entirely by mail in all of Clallam County. The purpose of this election is to nominate the top 2 candidates from each contest for the General Election Ballot, to elect new Precinct Committee Officers, and to accept or reject local ballot measures. Ballots for this election will be mailed to all qualified voters on July 15, 2020.

**VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES:** Pursuant to RCW 29A.08.140, the registration deadlines for all precincts within the districts voting in the Primary will be as follows:

Online or by mail: Last day to register or update registration is July 27, 2020 (Registrations must be received by the Auditor’s Office by this date). Printable voter registration forms can be found online at [www.clallam.net/elections](http://www.clallam.net/elections). You can also register using the online portal at [www.votewa.gov](http://www.votewa.gov).

In-person: Last day to register or update registration at the Clallam County Auditor’s Office is August 4, 2020. You may register to vote or update your registration at the Auditor’s Office, 223 E 4<sup>th</sup> St, Suite 1 in Port Angeles between 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Election Day, August 4, we are open until 8:00 p.m.

A registered voter who fails to transfer his or her residential address by this deadline may vote according to his/her previous registration address.

**VOTING AID:** To assist elderly and disabled persons in voting their ballot, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Auditor’s Office beginning July 15, 2020 through 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.

**OPEN PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE:** The Canvassing Board of Clallam County, pursuant to chapter 29A.60 RCW, will hold public meetings on the following dates and times:
