Thank you for your interest in applying to the Clallam County Fair Royalty Ambassador program.

You will have the opportunity to meet people and make new friends in and out of Clallam County by promoting the fair in parades, civic events, and participating at the **CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR**.

The **CLALLAM COUNTY FAIR ROYALTY** program is open to any high school student **residing and living in Clallam County**. Candidate must be enrolled in a high school/home school/private program with the same Freshman, Sophomore, Junior, and Senior qualifications. GPA of 2.50 is needed to apply, ages 14-18.

Court selection is based on personality, poise, appearance, presentation, responsibility, attendance, punctuality, initiative, and attitude. Judging at fair board meet and greet, a dessert with judges and coronation all contribute to being a court member. Knowledge of the Clallam County Fair facts will be important. It will be the Royalty Committee's decision to determine the size of court each year.

Please look at **EVENT DATE SHEET on page 7** carefully and determine if you are able to attend **ALL** mandatory dates listed. The new court **MUST** be able to attend all royalty dates listed on Event Date Sheet. After court selection, not adhering to mandatory dates, **WILL** affect outcome of the scholarship. It is **MANDATORY** for **CURRENT** royalty to attend the next year's coronation in order to receive the scholarship. Royalty court will serve for one year, from coronation to coronation.

ROYALTY CONTRACT-PLEASE READ ALL INFORMATION

1. One who was royalty from a previous year is ineligible for one year. If one has been crowned queen, they are retired. Royalty court will serve from one year (coronation to coronation).
2. Candidate/Court agrees not to enter any other beauty, popularity, scholarship or like contest, outside of the local school or community during that one year term.
3. Candidate must be enrolled in a high school/home school/private school, ages 14-18. Because Fair Royalty program provides a scholarship, candidate must have a GPA of 2.50 or better upon application and must maintain this GPA until graduation. Candidate must have a commutative school attendance record of 90%. Candidate will abide by the Washington State Truancy Law (the "Becca Bill") regarding absence during any school year. Candidate/court that is continually truant or have unexcused attendance, may be put on temporary suspension or may be disqualified from continuing to be a part of the royalty court, thus losing all awards, scholarships, and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee.
4. Alcohol consumption, smoking, vaping, use of non-prescription drugs, recreational drugs or otherwise immoral and illegal conduct by candidate or court, will result in automatic and immediate disqualification. Candidate/court cannot be involved or have been charged with illegal activities. Any or all listed can be subject to immediate dismissal and forfeiture of scholarship.
5. Candidate/court and families, will always maintain consideration and good conduct to Royalty Committee, Judges, Fair Board, and anybody associated with the Clallam County Fair. This must be maintained at all times. Candidate/court must be of good character, shall not have been or currently married, pregnant or have a child prior to or while representing fair royalty in the court of the one year. Candidate/court member, cannot co-habitat with an intimate partner.
6. Candidate/court will arrive promptly and on time, to all functions. Two or more unexcused tardies or missed events may result in suspension from any function and/or dismissal from the royalty court altogether and loss of scholarship funds. An excused absence is as follows: death of an immediate family member, serious illness via doctors note, prior authorization from royalty committee.
7. There will be no tattooing or body piercing as candidate or court member. Visible piercings such as brows, nose, lips, tongue, etc will have to be removed. Normal ear piercing is acceptable. Visible tattoos will need to be covered. Men cannot have facial piercing including earring and/or gauges. Please do not color your hair after orientation unless you have received permission from Royalty Committee.
8. Cell phones cannot be used during work days or scheduled events unless permission has been given by the Royalty Committee. Please ask your family and friends not to call you or text you during your times involved as candidate or court member.
9. **SOCIAL PLANS AND JOB SCHEDULES** cannot interfere with any royalty activity. Candidate/court must attend all the assigned royalty functions. Missed events will affect outcome of becoming royalty court and after court selection will effect outcome of royalty scholarship. One needs to be flexible with added dates. You will need to contact royalty committee for any changes in schedule. Contacting anybody else does not count.
10. **The Royalty Committee will set and determine clothing guidelines for ALL events.** If you come to a event dressed inappropriately, you will be sent home and the event will be considered unexcused. No flip flops, sandals, or slippers. Clothing

cannot be low cut or have inappropriate sayings on them. No PJ bottoms and no shorts can be worn to any work day or any event or while traveling to and from any event. A gown will need to be purchased for the coronation. The gown cannot be low cut either in front or back, cannot have slits, and must have straps. A picture of the gown, front and back, will be sent and will need to be approved by the committee. Only the gown approved by the committee can be worn at coronation. NO SUBSTITUTIONS. If you come to coronation with a different gown, you will be marked down and you will be asked to go home and get the one that was approved.

11. **FACEBOOK/SOCIAL MEDIA.** You are expected to treat Facebook AND ALL SOCIAL MEDIA as you would your personal behavior. No profane language, no bullying, no sexual pictures, no firearm posting, no alcoholic beverages, no smoking or vaping, shall appear in any posting. **You will maintain the highest level of integrity and poise and will avoid even the slightest implication of inappropriate behavior.**
You will be asked to "friend" a member of the royalty committee and your Facebook and other social media will be looked at periodically.
12. Candidates/court will need to check email, voicemail, text messages regularly as this is how committee will be providing information and you will need to respond promptly.
13. Chaperon's will be furnished by the royalty committee. Royalty is to remain under the chaperon's supervision traveling to, during and returning from all events. Candidate/court will provide their own transportation to and from all designated meeting place.
14. One requiring special needs will furnish their own helpers and/or equipment at the applicant's expense. Candidate/court will be responsible for medical coverage.
15. No reproduction of any photographs taken by any professional photographer unless they have written authorization/permission by said photographer. If pictures are posted, they must give credit to professional photographer.
16. Parents are welcome to attend events listed, however all will be respectful to royalty committee for decisions made, fair manager and those involved with fair royalty. Rules laid down for candidate and court also apply to parents/family. Parents/family, friends are responsible for their own transportation to any event. Royalty committee will only pay for royalty court at events. Parents/family, friends may be asked to leave any event if royalty committee deems so.
17. If court member, it is family's responsibility to provide housing arrangements during fair which will include where is court member staying each night, how is court member getting to fair each morning and how is court member getting home each night. Committee provides lunch, dinner and snacks during fair but not breakfast nor does committee provide money for personal hygiene.
18. After royalty clothes are picked out and purchased, those clothing items will be the only allowed clothing items to wear. Parents will be respectful of decisions made by royalty committee. Committee provides hat, tiara, sash, shirt, pants, belt and boots. No other accessories or other clothing can be purchased by parent/other person for royalty to wear. If items are lost or not maintained, it will be the financial responsibility of court member to replace.

EVENT INFORMATION

ROYALTY CONTRACT

PARENT(S)/GUARDIAN(S) AND CANDIDATE

(I) (WE) have read, understand and agree to abide by **ALL** the Rules for Clallam County Fair Royalty. It is agreed that the Candidate has a 2.50 GPA or better at time of orientation meeting and will maintain this until high school graduation. Transcript will be required before scholarship.

(I) (WE) have read and understand that all work days and events are mandatory and if candidate/court member does not attend these mandatory dates and ALL FOUR days of Fair short of illness, death in family, or some unforeseen incident, may result in an immediate dismissal or probation, and forfeiture of any scholarship funds, awards and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee.

(I) (WE) - In the event I should be chosen as one of the Clallam County Fair Royalty court, I understand and agree that I will be available through my royalty year (coronation to coronation) to participate in and to fulfill obligations as designated by the Royalty Committee.

(I) (WE) have read and understand that the Royalty Committee and other organization members, may dismiss any Candidate/court member from serving as Royalty if, in its opinion, the Candidate/court member is such that dismissal would be in the best interest of the Clallam County Fair/Royalty and/or the Candidate.

If any of the conditions herein should be violated by the Candidate/court member, the Royalty Committee will notify Candidate/court member of the alleged violation and give Candidate/court member an opportunity to appear before selected members of the Royalty Committee, Fair Manager and organization members and respond to any alleged violations. The Royalty Committee, Fair Manager and or other appointed members representing the Clallam County Fair Royalty may dismiss or suspend any Candidate/court member from serving as royalty at any function, if in the board's opinions conduct and behavior is such that dismissal would be in the best interest of the Clallam County Fair and Fair Royalty and the community. Such violations that occurs within the term and are recognized within six (6) months after that term, may result in the forfeiture of scholarships, awards and attire furnished by the Royalty Committee. In the event of dismissals, all clothes and accessories purchased by the Royalty Committee must be returned to the Royalty Committee within seven (7) days of the written request. This may also include any cash awards or scholarship given.

Lessee, its officers, employees and members shall, through the signing of this Agreement by an authorized party or agent, defend, indemnify and hold harmless County, its officials, employees, volunteers and agents from any and all damages, costs or expenses in law or equity, including attorney fees, costs and expenses that may at any time arise because of damages to property, bodily injury, including death or personal injury received by reason of any action or omission by Lessee.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

IF REQUIREMENTS HAVE NOT BEEN MET SUCH AS LACK OF PARTICIPATION AND NOT HONORING ROYALTY CONTRACT, IT WILL AFFECT THE OUTCOME OF THE SCHOLARSHIP. Court will need to attend the next years (2021) coronation to receive scholarship. There is a two year period of time to ask and receive scholarship which starts from time of high school graduation. After two years the scholarship will not be awarded.

PLEASE READ THIS SECTION VERY CAREFULLY.

There is a one year waiting time (coronation to coronation) to be able to receive scholarship and one must have graduated from high school.

Those selected for the Clallam County Fair Royalty Court will receive the following scholarship:

Queen The scholarship awarded will be \$500.00

Princess The scholarship awarded will be \$400.00

General Rules:

In order to receive a Clallam County Fair Royalty scholarship, Candidates must have a 2.50 GPA or better upon application at orientation. Candidates must be enrolled in an accredited high school program, home school or private school. From time of Candidates becoming actual royalty court, the 2.50 GPA must be maintained for the length of time student is in school. There is a waiting time of one-year (coronation to coronation) to be able to receive scholarship and one must have graduated from high school meeting the criteria of Washington State for high school seniors to receive scholarship. If court member does not attend the next year's coronation, scholarship will automatically be withdrawn. Only ACCREDITED universities, colleges or tech schools, are eligible for royalty scholarship. Court member will give Royalty Committee name of school and address where scholarship is going along with student ID number. Check is mailed directly to school and no check will be given to court member or family member.

If royalty contract is not honored, court member will forfeit scholarship and will be asked to return all and any royalty clothes or items that royalty committee has given them.
