***YELLOW FEVER VACCINATION**

Because of a total depletion of YF-Vax, the manufacturer (Sanofi Pasteur) has worked with CDC and the US Food and Drug Administration to make an alternative yellow fever vaccine, **Stamaril**, available at select locations until YF-Vax supply returns, which is expected by mid-2019. No one on the peninsula has this vaccine available. A list of Seattle area pharmacies that have vaccine is available on the CDC website:

Going places? Travel immunizations and oral medications are available at your Safeway Pharmacy at select locations. Up to 70% of travelers report some sort of health problem during or after their trip, especially those traveling to tropical locations. The best way to avoid health problems overseas is to get your immunizations before you leave. And the most convenient way to get them is at your neighborhood Safeway Pharmacy. Before you travel, make sure to stop at the Safeway Pharmacy where you can receive all required and recommended immunizations and fill your oral prescription medications.

How It Works

1. Complete your **Travel Health Profile**. There will be a **\$49 charge** from our Travel Medicine specialist physician that will provide the recommendations for your trip.
2. In the Travel Health Profile select the store to which your recommendations will be transmitted.
3. The Pharmacy staff at the store you have selected will contact you within 2 business days to discuss your immunization recommendations and set up an appointment for your pre-travel consultation and to administer your travel immunizations.

Please note: Allow as much time as possible before your trip, as some immunization series need to be started a few weeks or even months before travel. Age restrictions vary by state. See Pharmacy for details.

All immunizations necessary for overseas travel are available at your Safeway Travel Health Pharmacy, such as: Yellow Fever; Tetanus, Diphtheria and Pertussis; Hepatitis A; Hepatitis B; Flu*; Rabies; Japanese Encephalitis; Meningococcal; Measles, Mumps and Rubella; Varicella; Typhoid Fever; and Polio
