

Meadowbrook Creek Segmented Sampling



Water samples were collected from either public access points or with owner permission.

Washington State Department of Ecology categorizes locations as impaired if a geometric mean is greater than 50 CFU/100ml or any single sample is greater than 100 CFU/100ml. Clallam County Environmental Health further categorizes results as:

High priority: > 400 CFU/100ml
Medium priority: 100 to 399 CFU/100ml
Low Priority: 50 to 99 CFU/100ml

Due to natural stream meandering, Meadowbrook Creek has changed over the course of this study. MC1 (MC1a or MC1b) is always the mouth of the creek even though that location shifts. MC2 changed to MC2a at the end of 2016 due to a large estuary repair and road construction project. As can be seen on the graph below, Meadowbrook Creek on average has fallen into either the lowest impairment category or has been healthy.

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
