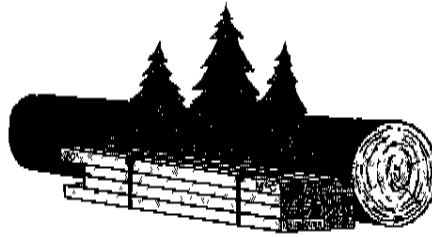
Rebekah and Miranda –
