I applaud you for your comments on the inaccuracy of our County shoreline reaches.

Several members of the Advisory Committee for the SMP Update have made public comment on the SMP web site where I read your comment..

Bob Vreeland's comments posted 9/01/11 and several of my comments address the inaccuracies found on nearly every one of 18 marine and 64 freshwater reaches in Clallam County.

I did a documented comment (taken from the Inventory and characterization report) on Shoreline Public Access to Public land and the taking of private property for more Public access. I tried to stress the fact that it is not lack of public land, it is the lack of public access to that publically owned land, that is the problem.

Only 17.1% or less of Clallam County proper is privately owned land, documented by Callam County's future use map.

How long can our county survive with such a limited tax base?

Thank you for trying to clarifying just how much **Park land is available for Public Access and use.**
