It has come to my attention that Dungeness Bay shoreline might be designated as Priority feeder bluff.

Our Dungeness Bay shoreline is not high, steep or seriously eroding. It is sheltered and not subject to severe wave and current action. It should be designated as bay, not as "priority feeder bluff"

The Proposed 150 ft. setback for the "priority feeder bluff" designation is extreme. The "bay" designation proposes 50 ft. setback.

I have own my property here on [REDACTED] Anderson Rd [REDACTED] for 10 years. The bluff has mature trees growing on the bank and below the bank all the way to the water. There is appr. 50 feet from the bottom of the bank to the water.

As affected shoreline property owners, the County should keep us promptly and clearly informed about the proposed and their consequences and actively promote ongoing discussion.
