"Why is Clallam County staff asking unformed people that attend Public Forums to answer questions based on what they think, when they don't know anything?"

So that Clallam County employees can use their **loaded statistics from the Public Forum Comments**, answered by the uninformed, based on what they think, when they don't know anything, as a major contributing factors to determine the contents and outcome of the Clallam County SMP UPDATE.

EVERY informed, affected, **private property owner** that has written or emailed one of the 329 Public Comments to the SMP website is entitled to this information.

With **51% PUBLIC ACCESS** in Clallam County, the HIGHEST of any county in WA State? The Public Forum Questionnaire asked? If we needed more PUBLIC ACCESS? (mote point)

I am requesting the Commissioners, Planning Dept Members, County employees and the SMP Committee members **question the validity** of the the Public Forum Questionnaire Comments, in deciding the fate of Clallam County private property owners on the Appointed DOE SMP Update.

Subject: Status of DRAFT SMP & NEW Committee Meeting Date

Shoreline Advisory Committee Members:

We received a significant amount of comments/perspectives from the Committee as well as the public that are shaping the update of the *February 2012 Working Draft SMP*. We have made substantial progress, but are not quite done yet with the Draft Shoreline Master Program (SMP). We are working hard to try to complete a majority of the revisions this week, but will need a few more days next-week to work with the consultant for final editing and map production.

We are confident we will have a document ready for public release and your review next-week.

Based on a next-week document-release date, **we are going to *reschedule* the planned December 4th meeting to Tuesday, December 11, 2012.**

This will allow one more week for your first review of the revised draft document.

Overall, Committee members will have around 60-days to review prior to the scheduled *January 15, 2013* meeting.

Jim Johannessen, Licensed Eng. Geologist, MS, Coastal Geologic Services, Inc., will be at the December 11, 2012, meeting. Mr. Johannessen consulted on the marine bluffs, feeder bluffs, erosion and marine sediment transport processes, as well as related buffer and geotechnical analysis needed at the project/parcel level. We received a lot of comments from both the Committee and public on these issues. Mr. Johannessen will likely need to depart by early-afternoon, so we will address the bluff/buffer/geotechnical analysis standards earlier in the agenda.
