ADOPTING THE ANNUAL CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FOR 2022

THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS finds as follows:

1. The annual construction program, for the year beginning in 2022, is ready for adoption.
2. It is the practice and policy of Clallam County that when required, full environmental review of the projects listed in the annual program are made at the time when a project is ready to begin. Detailed engineering drawings, specifications and other facts are available to enable an environmental assessment made at that time to be based upon full and complete information concerning the project.
3. The annual construction program, in compliance with WAC 136-16-010 through -042, outlines expected projects and thus provides guidance to the Public Works Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Clallam County Board of Commissioners, in consideration of the above findings of fact:

1. The adoption of the Clallam County Annual Construction Program for 2022, not being an action within the definitions of the State Environmental Policy Act, does not require either the preparation of any environmental documentation, or a determination as to environmental significance.
2. The Annual Construction Program for 2022 is hereby adopted.

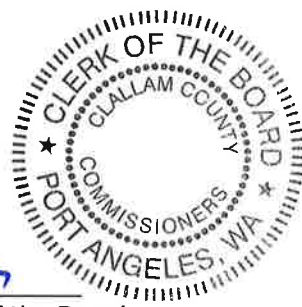
