

**ANIMAL ISSUES ADVISORY COMMITTEE Clallam
County
Minutes
March 20, 2014**

The meeting was called to order at 6:00 pm by Patti Morris, Chair

Members Present: Marc Reinertson, Tommie Schwent, Patti Morris, Barbara Sanford, Paula Creasey, Alice Hoffman, Tracey Kellas, and Brian Smith

Minutes: Minutes from the February 20, 2014 meeting were read. Barbara Sanford made the motion to approve. Brian Smith seconded. Approved unanimously.

Old Business:

Chapters 17.09, 17.02, and 17.04 were reviewed for changes suggested and approved by the AIAC on 01/17/13 originally.

17.02 Dogs and Cats- Brian Smith made the motion to approve and move for legal review with numbering changes. Marc Reinertson seconded. Approved unanimously.

17.04 Livestock - Tracey provided language for "shelter for livestock" to be inserted. Brian Smith made the motion to approve and move for legal review with the new language inserted. Paula Creasey seconded. Approved unanimously.

17.03 Potentially Dangerous and Dangerous Dogs- Brian Smith made the motion to approve and move for legal review. Marc Reinertson seconded. Approved unanimously.

Tracey made suggestions on Chapter 17.05 Rabies and Quarantine. She pointed out that WAC now requires rabies so the rabies vaccination portions (.015 & .020) need not exist in county code. Suggested changing the title to "Quarantine" only. Suggested home quarantine language is added as 17.05.41 and provided the language. Committee suggests the County/Sheriff's website contain information that rabies is covered under WAC for the public's information. Marc Reinertson made the motion to approve as suggested and move for legal review. Brian Smith seconded. Approved unanimously.

Chapter 17.06 Impound Procedures- Brian Smith made the motion to approve and submit for legal review. Marc Reinertson seconded. Approved unanimously.

New Business:

Chapter 17.08 Leash Control Area – Discussed if this chapter was needed in county code since the County has no official "leash control area". Decision was to leave in for future use. Brian Smith made the motion for no changes. Seconded by Tommy Schwent. Approved unanimously.

Chapter 17.11 Inherently Dangerous Animals – discussed not changing because the "at time of adoption" language will renew the grandfathering in date for 17.11.010. Members will review and discuss further at next meeting.

Agreed to continue to work on Kennels and Catteries chapter. Define who needs to be inspected. Noted that the RCW has a maximum of 50 for unneutered but no limit for neutered.

17.11 and 17.09 will be reviewed at next meeting.
