FACTS ABOUT...

2- WOMEN'S HEALTH SCREENING

- 3 out of 4 adult women in Clallam County have ever had a mammogram

74% ($\pm 6%$) of adult women have had a mammogram; 88% ($\pm 8%$) of women 40-49 years and 94% ($\pm 5%$) of women 50 years and over have had a mammogram.

- Most women 40 years and over have had a mammogram within the past two years

85% ($\pm 10%$) of women 40-49 years, 86% ($\pm 7%$) of women 50-64 years, and 86% ($\pm 7%$) of women 65 and over have had a mammogram within the past two years. (Figure 2.1)

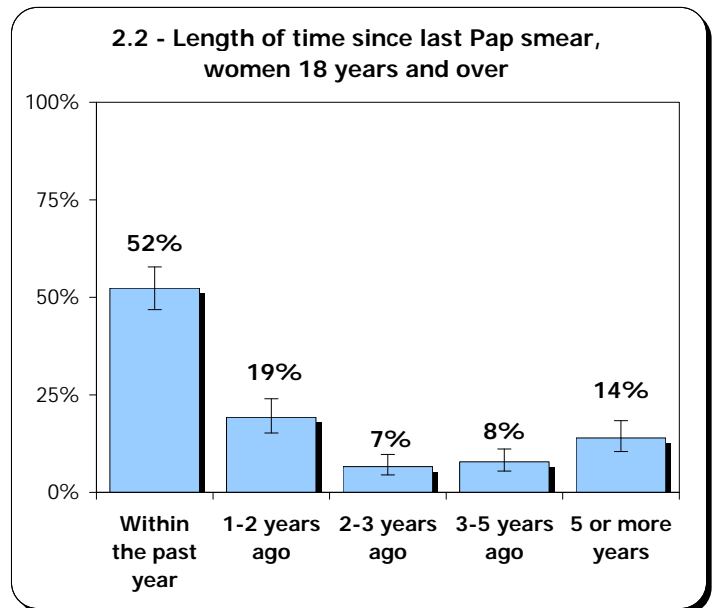
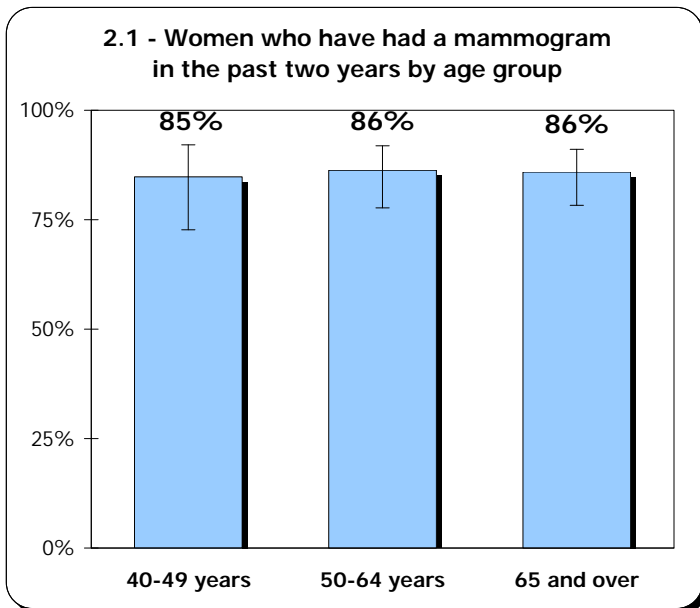
Healthy People 2010 goal: increase to 70% the proportion of women 40 years and over who have had a mammogram in the past two years.

- Most adult women have had a clinical breast exam within the past two years

Of the 95% ($\pm 3%$) of adult women in Clallam County who have ever had a clinical breast exam, 66% ($\pm 6%$) had the exam within the past year and 16% ($\pm 5%$) had the exam within the past two years.

- Most adult women have had a Pap smear within the past three years

Of the 97% ($\pm 2%$) of adult women in Clallam County who have ever had a clinical breast exam, 52% ($\pm 5%$) had the exam within the past year, 19% ($\pm 6%$) within the past two years, and 7% ($\pm 3%$) within the past three years. (Figure 2.2)
