

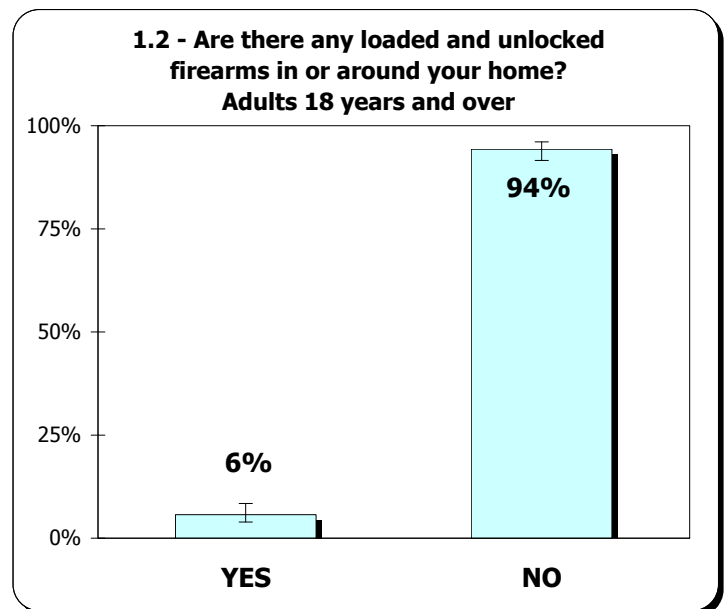
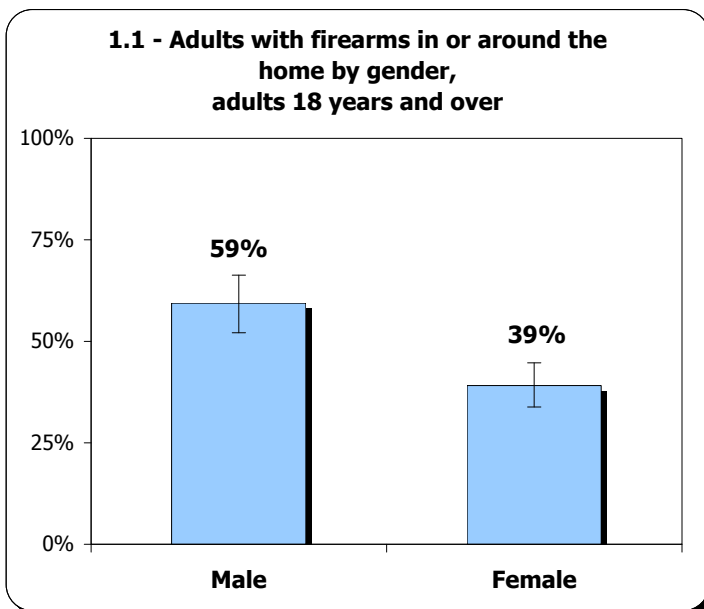
MODULE IX: INJURY PREVENTION - FIREARMS AND FAMILY VIOLENCE

FACTS ABOUT...

1- FIREARMS

- 1 out of 2 Clallam County adults have firearms in or around their homes
49% (± 5%) of adults 18 years and over have firearms in or around their homes.
- 1 out of 2 adults living in households with children report having firearms in or around their homes
45% (± 9%) of adults with children less than 18 in the household report having firearms in or around their homes; compared to 51% (± 5%) of adults living in households without children.
- Men are more likely to report having firearms in or around their homes than women
59% (± 7%) of adult men report having firearms in or around their homes; compared to 39% (± 6%) of women. (Figure 1.1)
- 1 in 20 adults has loaded and unlocked firearms in or around their home
6% (± 2%) of adults 18 years and over report having loaded and unlocked firearms in or around their homes. (Figure 1.2)

Healthy People 2010 goal: reduce the proportion of persons living in homes with firearms that are loaded and unlocked to 16 percent or less.
