## 5- CHARACTERISTICS OF THE UNINSURED

- 6 out of 10 Clallam County adults without health insurance are employed

61% ( $\pm 12\%$ ) of adults 18 years and over without health care coverage were employed for wages or self-employed, only 22% ( $\pm 11\%$ ) of adults without health insurance were unemployed. (Figure 5.1)

- 4 out of 10 adults without health insurance are married

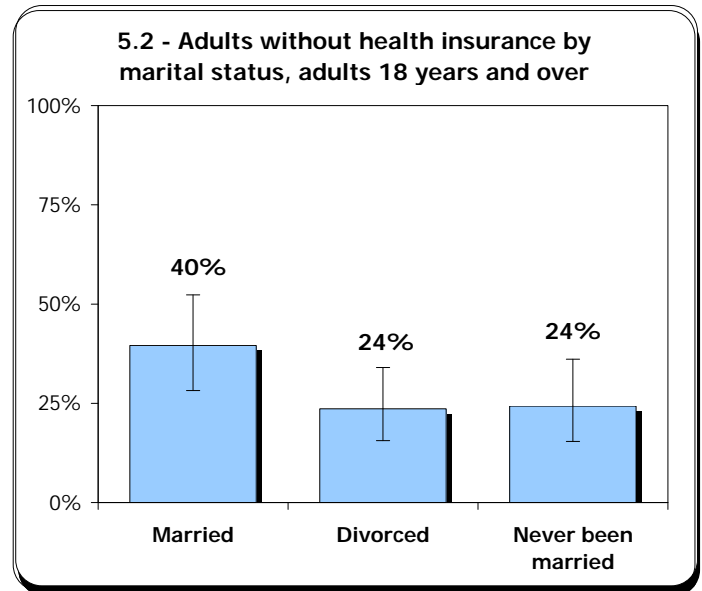
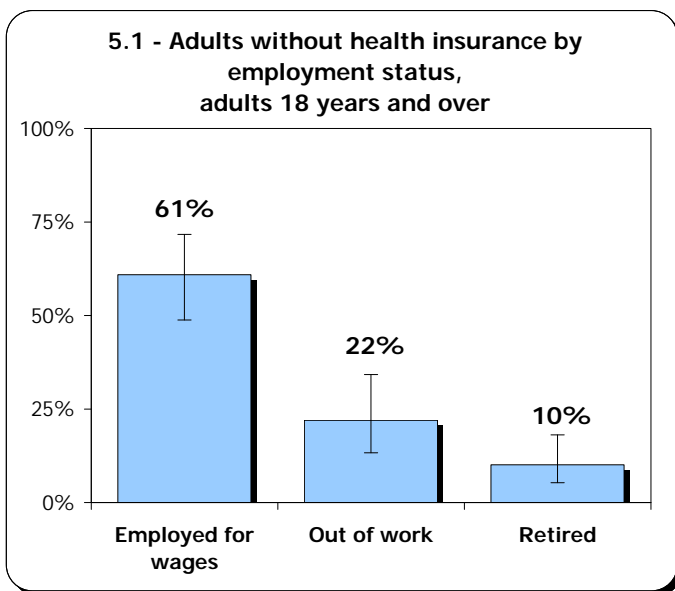
40% ( $\pm 12\%$ ) of adults 18 years and over without health care coverage were married, 24% ( $\pm 9\%$ ) were divorced, and 24% ( $\pm 11\%$ ) had never been married. (Figure 5.2)

- 4 out of 10 adults without health insurance have children

37% ( $\pm 12\%$ ) of adults 18 years and over without health care coverage had children less than 18 years living in their home.

- 1 out of 3 adults without health insurance goes to a public health clinic or community health center when they need care

30% ( $\pm 15\%$ ) of adults 18 years and over without health care coverage went to a public health clinic or community health center when they were sick or needed advice about their health, 54% ( $\pm 14\%$ ) went to a doctor's office or HMO for care.
