DISSOLVING THE ANIMAL ISSUES ADVISORY COMMITTEE

THE BOARD OF CLALLAM COUNTY COMMISSIONERS finds as follows:

1. Resolution 34, 1996, adopted by the Board of Commissioners on March 12, 1996, created the Animal Shelter Advisory Committee and established the purpose of the committee. Resolution 37, 1999, adopted on May 4, 1999, renamed the committee the Animal Issues Advisory Committee and modified its purpose. Resolution 59, 2002, adopted on June 18, 2002, abolished, recreated and redefined the Animal Issues Advisory Committee. Resolution 66, 2011, adopted on September 27, 2011 restructured the committee. Resolution 17, 2014, adopted on February 18, 2014 restructured the committee.
2. The Prosecuting Attorney's Office reviewed the status of the Animal Issues Advisory Committee, determined no meeting had taken place since September 2017 and inquired as to the need for the committee moving forward.
3. July 8, 2019, the Board of Commissioners received a request from the Sheriff's Department to dissolve the committee due to the committee's failure to meet at least annually.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Clallam County Commissioners, in consideration of the above findings of fact:

1. The Animal Issues Advisory Committee is hereby dissolved effective July 23, 2019.
