



NOTICE OF PRIMARY

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, that on Tuesday, the 2nd day of August, 2022, a Primary will be conducted entirely by mail in Clallam County. The purpose of this election is to nominate the top 2 candidates from each contest for the General Election Ballot. Ballots for this election will be mailed to all qualified voters on July 13, 2022.

VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINES: Pursuant to RCW 29A.08.140, the registration deadlines for all precincts within the districts voting in the Primary will be as follows:

Online or by mail: Last day to register or update registration is July 25, 2022 (Registrations must be received by the Elections and Voter Registration Office). Printable voter registration forms



can be found online at www.clallam.net/elections. You can also register using the online portal at www.votewa.gov.

In-person: Last day to register or update registration at the Election and Voter Registration Office is August 2, 2022. You may register to vote or update your registration at the Elections and Voter Registration Office, 223 E 4th St, Room 042 in Port Angeles between 9:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. On Election Day, August 2, we are open until 8:00 p.m.

A registered voter who fails to transfer his or her residential address by these deadlines may vote according to his/her previous registration address.

VOTING AID: To assist elderly and disabled persons in voting their ballot, an Accessible Voting Unit is available in the Elections and Voter Registration Office, Room 042, beginning July 13, 2022 during business hours and until 8:00 p.m. on Election Day.
