## **COVID BOOSTER EVENT**

With the recent approval of COVID booster shots by the FDA, CDC and other agencies, Clallam County Emergency Management and Clallam County Health and Human Services are developing plans for a mass vaccination event in Port Angeles, similar to those that were held this past spring.

Working with the Port Angeles School District, we will again utilize the auxiliary gym at the Port Angeles High School for the events. North Olympic Healthcare Network is assisting with our event.

Starting Friday, October 1st at 9 am, application for a reservation for the shot can be accessed on the internet by applying at <http://vaccine.clallam.net/register>. There will be some questions as you sign up, but it is very easy and there should be no trouble. If you find it difficult or know someone that doesn't have computer/internet access, you can call our message center at 360-417-2430 and we can help.

Booster shots are available to those persons that originally received the Pfizer vaccine series. You must be over 65, are over 18 with an underlying health condition or have a job that puts you at risk. Of course, if you have NOT had a vaccine yet, you can sign up for your first shot as well to start the two shot series.

As Moderna comes on line and approved for boosters, we will work to schedule those folks as well.
